Currently the Washington D.C. Bureau Chief for the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, James has served in many high-profile communication roles for the federal government.

Prior to his current role, James was the Mid-Atlantic Spokesman for the Transportation Security Administration, and Communications Director for the U.S. Senate Committee on Veterans' Affairs.

James also teaches courses in Native American Political Leadership for George Washington University's Graduate School of Political Management. Many Native American, Alaskan Native, Pacific Islander and other indigenous scholars seek out his classes.

"James is a mentor to his students, as well as his friends and colleagues," said Nathan Havey, a fellow UNC alumnus. "He is a man of incredible drive, integrity and vision."

James was born and raised on Hawai'i Island and graduated from Kealakehe High School. One of the few from his social circle to go to college, he has always

## DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR AWARD: RICHARD KILLMER, BA-60



RICHARD KILLMER BA-60

Richard Killmer is Professor of Oboe at the renowned Eastman School of Music at the University of Rochester and has been recognized as one of the greatest oboists of the past fifty years. He was the principal oboist for the St. Paul Symphony Orchestra for 11 years.

In 2011, Dr. Killmer was awarded an Honorary Life Membership in the International Double Reed Society, and this year the international professional music society Mu Phi Epsilon, will honor him as their "Musician of the Year."

In addition to being an unparalleled performer, Richard is an outstanding educator. He is the 2006 recipient of the Yale School of Music's Gustave Stoeckel Excellence in Teaching award. He also served as a Visiting Professor of Oboe at Yale for six years. Many of Richard's former students have earned major teaching and performing positions in universities and symphony orchestras throughout the United States.

"Richard has been revered by an endless number of students and professionals throughout the United States and other countries."

As a Professor at Eastman, students and faculty hold Richard in the highest esteem. Recently, more than 70 first-year oboists auditioned for the six available spaces in his program.

"From his start as my student-teacher in Longmont, Colorado, to his steady and solid rise to a professional performer and superb teacher of music and oboe, he has been revered by an endless number of students and professionals throughout the United States and other countries," said Kenneth Evans, Emeritus Professor of Music at UNC.

Richard has played with the Boston Symphony, Oklahoma City Symphony and San Diego Chamber Orchestra, among others. During his three years in the Army he was principal oboist with the NORAD Band and baritone saxophonist in the NORAD Commander's Dance Band, performing on numerous recordings and television programs.



## DISTINGUISHED HONORARY ALUMNI OF THE YEAR AWARD: HANK AND NAN BROWN



HANK AND NAN BROWN

Hank and Nan were instrumental in the growth of the University of Northern Colorado and provided exemplary leadership in the greater Greeley community. They called Greeley home for decades.

"Hank and Nan have always been dedicated to the University of Northern Colorado, to the Greeley community, to Colorado, and to the nation," said Dick Monfort, chairman of the UNC Board of Trustees. "They have an extraordinary commitment to public service that has bettered all of our lives."

Hank Brown was the 11th president of UNC, serving from 1998 to 2002. As president, he increased admissions standards and maintained the lowest faculty-to-student teaching ratio of any four-year university in Colorado. Fundraising increased during his tenure and he secured several major gifts, including the transformational gift that gave the Monfort College of Business its name

Hank served Colorado in the U.S. Senate for six years and completed five consecutive terms in the U.S. House of Representatives. He also served in the Colorado State Senate from 1972 to 1976. From 1962 to 1966, Hank served in the U.S. Navy where he volunteered in Vietnam and was decorated for his combat service as a forward air controller.

Hank is an attorney with the Denver law firm of Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck and serves on the board of directors of the Daniels Fund. He was previously the president of the University of Colorado and a vice president at Monfort of Colorado.

Hank and Nan were married in 1967. They currently reside in Denver and enjoy spending time with their children and grandchildren.

The Browns made a profound and lasting impact at the University, which continues to influence higher education today.
